7. What is the purpose and how does the legislatively directed spending item provide a public benefit that is an appropriate use of taxpayer money?

The requested funding would support the purchase of a fire engine that strengthens fire suppression, rescue, and emergency response capability for Auburn Hills residents, businesses, and the surrounding region through established mutual aid partnerships. Auburn Hills protects a diverse and high-activity community that includes major employers, commercial corridors, and heavily traveled roadways, where reliable and timely fire response is critical to life safety and economic stability. This investment would ensure that each fire station is equipped with a dedicated engine, improving response reliability for simultaneous incidents and large-scale emergencies. A previous engine was removed from service in 2021 after becoming cost-prohibitive to repair, and this request represents an opportunity to restore full operational capability while modernizing the fleet. A new engine, estimated at

approximately \$1.2 million, would align with existing apparatus and training standards, enhance firefighter safety, and strengthen both local and regional emergency response capacity for the greater community.
